**1/ We are announcing a revision of the Class and Component Prices for June 2007 that were announced on June 29, 2007, due to a revision in the moisture content for 500 lb. Cheddar cheese published today by the National Agricultural Statistics Service for the week ending June 16th. The prices affected are the Class III Price, the Class III Skim Price, the Protein Price, and the Product Price Average for Cheese.**

2/ There is also a \$0.20 per cwt. processor assessment which is an obligation under the Fluid Milk Promotion Order (7 CFR §1160.101 et seq.). The Order requires that all persons who process and market commercially more than 3,000,000 pounds of fluid milk products in consumer-type packages in the 48 contiguous States and the District of Columbia on a monthly basis, excluding those fluid milk products delivered to the residence of a consumer, be assessed 20 cents per hundredweight on all marketings of such packaged fluid milk products during the month.
