**\* The manufacturing allowances and butterfat yield factor used to compute the Class II, Class III, Class IV, and component prices for September 2008 are those published in the *Federal Register* on December 29, 2006 (71 FR 78333). Beginning with October 2008, all future computations of advance Class I and Class II skim prices and pricing factors, and Class II, Class III, Class IV, and component prices will use the revised manufacturing allowances and butterfat yield factor contained in the Interim Final Rule published in the *Federal Register* on July 31, 2008 (73 FR 44617).**

<sup>1/</sup> There is also a \$0.20 per cwt. processor assessment which is an obligation under the Fluid Milk Promotion Order (7 CFR §1160.101 et seq.). The Order requires that all persons who process and market commercially more than 3,000,000 pounds of fluid milk products in consumer-type packages in the 48 contiguous States and the District of Columbia on a monthly basis, excluding those fluid milk products delivered to the residence of a consumer, be assessed 20 cents per hundredweight on all marketings of such packaged fluid milk products during the month.
