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Cheese, Butter Prices Decline

Prices for cheddar cheese on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange (CME) decreased slightly from mid-June to mid-July. The CME barrel price on July 14 was \$1.12 per pound, down 6½¢ from mid-June, while the 40-pound block price of \$1.16 was down 3½¢ from mid-June. Both prices are nearly 40¢ below year-earlier levels.

The CME butter price on July 14 was \$1.14½ per pound, down 3¢ from mid-June and nearly 50¢ below year-earlier levels.

The \$1.14½ price equals the lowest butter price in 2006, previously recorded in April.

The June Federal order Class III price of \$11.29 per cwt. was up 46¢ from May, but \$2.63 below the June 2005 price.

According to the "World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates" from USDA, Class III prices for 2007 are projected to average \$12.45 (+/- 50¢) next year, up from \$11.55 (+/- 15¢) in 2006.

June Milk Production Up 1.4%

Estimated U.S. milk production during June totaled 15.3 billion pounds, up 1.4% from June 2005. For the first six months of 2006, estimated U.S. milk production was up 3.7% from 2005. The increases are the result of increased milk production per cow, and a larger number of milk cows.

In Wisconsin, milk production was up 1.0% from a year earlier in June and up 3.2% for the first half of the year.

Milk production in Minnesota in June was down 0.4% from 2005, but 1.5% above a year earlier for the first half of the year.

- ➤ In June, 16,406 producers delivered to the market with an average daily delivery of 4,612 pounds.
- ➤ Producer milk totaled 2.2 billion pounds, down 111 million pounds from May, and 311 million pounds above June 2005.
- Class I utilization totaled 352 million pounds, down 5.2% on a daily basis
- from May. Class I usage accounted for 16.3% of producer milk.
- ➤ The June Producer Price Differential (PPD) is \$0.23 per cwt.
- The Statistical Uniform Price is \$11.52 per cwt., up \$0.31 from May, but \$2.60 below June 2005.

USDA Issues Notice of Intent to Reconvene Hearing to Amend Class III and IV Milk Price Formulas

The U. S. Department of Agriculture recently announced its intent to reconvene a national public hearing to amend the Class III and Class IV price formulas.

USDA will reconvene the national hearing, originally held January 24-27, 2006, in Alexandria, Virginia, to assure that any changes to manufacturing allowance factors used in Federal order Class III and Class IV product price formulas are

appropriate and reflective of manufacturing costs. USDA also welcomes additional proposals addressing the Federal order Class III and Class IV price formulas for further consideration in the reconvened hearing. The additional proposals are due on or before September 30, 2006. The notice of intent to reconvene the hearing was published as a proposed rule in the June 28 Federal Register.

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Sales of Fluid Milk Products

Sales of fluid milk products in the Upper Midwest Order in 2005 are shown graphically below with sales in all Federal orders and in California shown on Page 3.

Upper Midwest Order

During 2005, there were 4.4 billion pounds of fluid milk products sold in

the marketing area from all sources. On a monthly basis, sales averaged 367 million pounds during the year, ranging from 332 million pounds in June to 387 million pounds in December.


Sales of reduced fat milk (2%) accounted for the largest share of the market at 45%, followed by fat free (skim), whole, and lowfat (1%).

All Orders & California

Packaged sales of fluid milk products in all marketing areas and California totaled 50.2 billion pounds for the year.

Sales in each of the areas and the percentage they represented are shown in the graph on Page 3. The largest sales occurred in F.O. 1, the Northeast Order.


Packaged Sales of Fluid Milk Products in the Upper Midwest Marketing Area from all Sources -- 2005
