Cheese, Butter Prices Decline

Prices for cheddar cheese on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange (CME) decreased slightly from mid-July to mid-August. The CME barrel price on August 16 was \$1.89 per pound, down 4¢ from mid-July, while the 40-pound block price of \$1.95 was down 1¢ from mid-July. Both prices are approximately 70¢ above year-earlier levels.

The CME butter price on August 16 was \$1.38 per pound, down 10¢ from mid-July but nearly 10¢ above year-earlier levels.

Nonfat dry milk (NFDM) on the CME is currently at record highs. On August 16,

Extra Grade NFDM was \$1.93 per pound, and Grade A NFDM was \$2.11 per pound, both unchanged from mid-July. The year-earlier levels for Extra Grade and Grade A NFDM were both at \$0.90 per pound.

The July Federal order Class III price was a record high \$21.38 per cwt., up \$1.21 from June, and \$10.46 above the July 2006 price.

According to the "World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates" from USDA, the 2007 all milk price is forecast to average a record \$19.15 to \$19.35 per cwt.



July Milk Production Up 3.9%

Estimated U.S. milk production in the 23 major States during July totaled 14.5 billion pounds, up 3.9% from July 2006. For the first seven months of 2007, estimated U.S. milk production was up 1.4% from 2006. The increases are the result of increased milk production per cow, and a larger number of milk cows.

In Wisconsin, milk production was up 4.1% from a year earlier in July and up 2.6% for the first seven months of the year.

Milk production in Minnesota in July was up 3.0% from 2006 and up 3.4% for the first seven months of the year.

Pool Summary

- ➤ In July, 16,250 producers delivered to the market with an average daily delivery of 4,906 pounds.
- ➤ Producer milk totaled 2.4 billion pounds, up 401 million pounds from June, and 92 million pounds above July 2006.
- Class I utilization totaled 341 million pounds, down 4.1% on a daily basis
- from June. Class I usage accounted for 14.3% of producer milk.
- ➤ The July Producer Price Differential (PPD) is \$0.27 per cwt.
- The Statistical Uniform Price is \$21.65 per cwt., up \$1.53 from June, and \$10.35 above July 2006.
- ➤ Market statistics for July are shown on Pages 4 and 5.

Supply Plant Systems

Supply plants are defined in \$1030.6, with performance requirements defined in \$1030.7(c). In general, supply plants are required to ship 10% of their receipts to bottling plants.

These performance requirements can be met as a "system", as defined in §1030.7(f).

This provision allows two or more supply plants operated by one or more handlers to qualify for pooling by meeting the shipping requirements in the same manner as a single plant. In other words, an individual plant in a system does not need to qualify on its own, as long as the system as a whole qualifies.

Supply plants in a system generally must be located in the marketing area.

Class III Milk Prices -- January 1990 to July 2007

Class III milk prices under the Federal milk order system since 1990 are shown in the table below. The prices are also shown graphically for the last four years.

Class III is primarily milk used to make hard cheese, and is often referred to as the manufacturing milk price. (Class III milk also included butter until 2000.) The July 2007 Class III price of \$21.38 was a record high. For the year, the Class III price is averaging \$16.87. The previous yearly average high of \$15.39 was set in 2004.

Federal Order Class III Milk Prices - January 1990 through July 2007


