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CME Dairy Prices Continue Up in May

The prices for cheddar cheese on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange (CME) continued their pattern of volatility in the last month, but showed net increases for the period.

The CME barrel price on May 22 of \$1.60\(^1\)4 per pound was up 2\(^3\)4\(^c\) from April 22 and 3\(^3\)4\(^c\) above a year ago. On May 7, the barrel price reached \$1.74, it's highest level since November 2017, before falling 14\(^c\) in the next week.

The CME 40-pound block price on May 22 of \$1.68\footnote{4} was up $^{3}4$ \psi from a month ago and $4\frac{1}{2}$ \psi above last year. The price peak so far this year was late March at \$1.73.

The CME butter price on May 22 was \$2.34 per pound, up 7¢ from last month, but 11¢ below a year ago.

The price of nonfat dry milk (NFDM) on the CME on May 22 was \$1.043/4 per pound, up $43/4 \, \phi$ from last month and $19/4 \, \phi$ above a year ago.

The whey price on the CME on May 22 was 0.36% per pound, up 2% from April 22, but % below last May.

The April 2019 Federal order Class III price was \$15.96 per cwt., \$0.92 above March and \$1.49 above last year.

The CME Class III futures on May 22 had the price at \$16.33 for May, going above \$17 for just one month in September, before declining to \$16.20s for the first few months of 2020. If the Class III price follows the futures market the rest of the year, it will average \$16.01 for 2019, up \$1.40 from the 2018 average.



Pool Summary

- ➤ In April, producer milk totaled 3.01 billion pounds, down from last month, but above last year.
- ➤ Class I utilization was 231 million pounds, up 4.5% from March on a daily basis, but 9.4% below last year. In April, Class I use was 7.7% of producer milk.
- ➤ The April Producer Price Differential (PPD) was \$0.15 per cwt.
- ➤ The Statistical Uniform Price was \$16.11 per cwt., up \$0.83 from March and \$1.57 above last year.
- ➤ Market statistics for April are shown on Pages 3, 4 and 5.

puring December 2018, 74% of producer milk was received from Wisconsin, with 18% from Minnesota. (See the table below.)

The remaining producer milk, about 8%, was primarily received from Illinois, Iowa, Michigan, North Dakota, and South Dakota.

In addition, a small quantity of milk was pooled on the order from each of the states of Idaho, Indiana, Missouri, Nebraska, Ohio, and Oklahoma.

Producer milk in December 2018 totaled 2.95 billion pounds, up nearly

400 million pounds from the previous year because of a decline in the volume of eligible milk not pooled due to class price relationships.

The number of counties from which producer milk was received, the number of producers, and pounds of producer milk represented by each state in December 2018 are shown in the table below.

In addition, the percentage of producer milk represented by each state is shown for December 2018, 2017, and 2016.

The map on Page 3 depicts the states and counties from which producer milk was received in December 2018.




