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CME Dairy Prices Mixed in September

Dairy prices on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange (CME) have seen mixed results compared to their prices in August. Blocks and Barrels are down, but butter, nonfat dry milk (NFDM), and whey were up from last month. All commodities were lower than their prices last year at this time, as shown in the graph below.


The CME barrel price on September 20 for cheddar cheese was \$1.61 per pound, down 19³/₄¢ from August, and down 56¢ from last year. Meanwhile, the 40-pound block price for cheddar cheese on the CME on

September 20 was \$1.80 per pound, down $22^{3/4}\phi$ from last month, and $25^{1/4}\phi$ below last year.

The CME butter price on September 20 was \$2.84 per pound, up 14¢ from last month, but down 31¢ from last year. The CME price for NFDM on September 20 was \$1.12³/₄ per pound, up 2¹/₄¢ from August, but 43¹/₄¢ below last year.

The CME whey price on September 20 was $\$0.28\frac{3}{4}$ per pound, up $1\frac{3}{4}$ ¢ from last month but down $16\frac{3}{4}$ ¢ below last year.

Pool Summary

- ➤ In August, producer milk was 2.8 billion pounds, up 0.2% daily from July but down 3.4% from last August.
- ➤ Class I use was 160 million pounds, up 8.4% daily from July but 4.5% below last year. In August, Class I use was 5.7% of total producer milk.
- ➤ The August 2023 Producer Price Differential (PPD) was \$0.16 per cwt.
- ➤ The F.O. 30 Statistical Uniform Price in August was \$17.35 per cwt., up \$3.17 from July, but down \$3.25 from last year.
- ➤ Market statistics for August are shown on Pages 4 and 5.

2022 Sales of Fluid Milk Products




Figure 2 Monthly Average Packaged Sales of FMP in the Upper Midwest Marketing Area from all Sources

Sales of fluid milk products (FMP) in the Upper Midwest Order from all sources are shown in Table 1 and are depicted graphically in Figures 1 and 2, with sales in all Federal orders shown in Figure 3 on Page 3.

Upper Midwest Order

During 2022, there were 3.0 billion pounds of fluid milk products sold in the marketing area from all sources. On a monthly basis, 2022 sales ranged from 219 million pounds in July to 270 million pounds in March.

In 2022, sales averaged 247 million pounds per month, down from 254 million pounds in 2021 and 366 million pounds in 2000, as shown in Figure 2. Since 2000, monthly average annual sales peaked at 371.5 million pounds in 2007 and have declined steadily since.

Sales of reduced fat milk (2%) continued to account for the largest share of the market at 35.5% in 2022, followed by lowfat milk (1%), then whole milk, and last was fat free milk (skim) by a fair margin.

Sales of 2% and skim milk declined in this region from 2021 to 2022, while sales of whole milk and 1% increased. The increase in sales of whole milk and 1% milk was not enough to offset the decline in the other two categories, causing a decrease in total sales for the year.

All Orders

Packaged sales of fluid milk products in all marketing areas totaled 39.8 billion pounds for the year. Sales in each of the areas and the percentage they represented are shown in Figure 3 on Page 3.



