CME Prices in June Maintained their Recent Gains.

Cheddar cheese barrels and blocks, butter, whey, and nonfat dry milk (NFDM) prices on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange (CME) in June continued to maintain their recent gains from May. The CME prices for all commodities were above the prices in June 2023. See the graph below.

The CME barrel price for cheddar cheese on June 17 was \$2.00 per pound, down 12½¢ from May but 47½¢ above last year. Meanwhile, the CME 40-pound block price for cheddar cheese was \$1.91½ per pound,


down $2\frac{3}{4}$ ¢ from last month, but 54¢ above last year.

The CME butter price on June 17 was $\$3.10\frac{3}{4}$ per pound, up $3\frac{3}{4}$ ¢ from last month and $74\frac{1}{4}$ ¢ above last year.

The CME price for NFDM on June 17 was \$1.19 $\frac{1}{4}$ per pound, up $2\frac{3}{4}$ ¢ from May, and $3\frac{1}{2}$ ¢ above last year.

The CME whey price on June 17 was \$0.48 per pound, up $6\frac{1}{2}$ ¢ from last month and $20\frac{1}{2}$ ¢ above last year.

Pool Summary

- ➤ In May, producer milk was 2.8 billion pounds, down 1.3% daily from April and 1.3% below last May.
- ➤ Class I use was 161 million pounds, down 3.2% daily from April and 0.8% below last year. In May, Class I use was 5.8% of total producer milk.
- ➤ The May 2024 Producer Price Differential (PPD) was \$0.19 per cwt.
- ➤ The F.O. 30 Statistical Uniform Price in May was \$18.74 per cwt., up \$2.79 from April, and \$2.25 above last year.
- ➤ Market statistics for April and May are shown on Pages 4 and 5.

2023 Annual Dairy Products Summary

The National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) recently published the "Dairy Products 2023 Summary", which details the monthly production of specified dairy products in the United States.

The table on Page 3 shows annual production and number of plants manufacturing selected dairy products in the United States for 2022 and 2023. Selected items from the table are summarized below. A breakdown of the information by state is included in the report, which is available on the NASS website (see URL in *Source*, Page 3).

Butter production in the United States during 2023 totaled 2.1 billion pounds, 2.7% above 2022. California accounted for 32% of butter production in 2023.

Total cheese production in 2023, excluding cottage cheeses, was 14.2 billion pounds, 0.9% above 2022. Wisconsin was the leading cheese producing state with 25% of the production, followed by California with 18%, Idaho and New Mexico with 7% each, and New York and Minnesota with 6%, each.

American type cheese production was 5.8 billion pounds, 3.0% above 2022. American cheese accounted for 41% of total cheese production in 2023. Wisconsin was the leading American cheese producing state with 19% of production, followed by Minnesota and California with 12% and 9%, respectively.

Italian cheese varieties production of 5.9 billion pounds in 2023 was 0.8% below 2022. Italian Cheese accounted for 41% of total cheese production in 2023. Mozzarella accounted for 79% of the Italian production, followed by Parmesan and Provolone with 8% and 6%, respectively. Wisconsin was the leading Italian cheese producing state with 29% of production, followed by California with 28%.

Nonfat dry milk production for human food, at 1.9 billion pounds, was down 4.4% from 2022. This product's volume often varies significantly from year to year, offsetting with changes to volumes of dry whole milk and skim milk powder production. California was the leading state with 42% of total production.

Dry whey production for human consumption totaled 886 million pounds, at par with 2022. Wisconsin was the leading state with 29% of total production. New York also accounted for a large percentage of the dry whey production with 15%.

Combined Ice Cream and Ice Cream Mix production (regular and lowfat) totaled 2.0 billion gallons and was down 5.2% from 2022. California was the leading state with 9% of total production.
