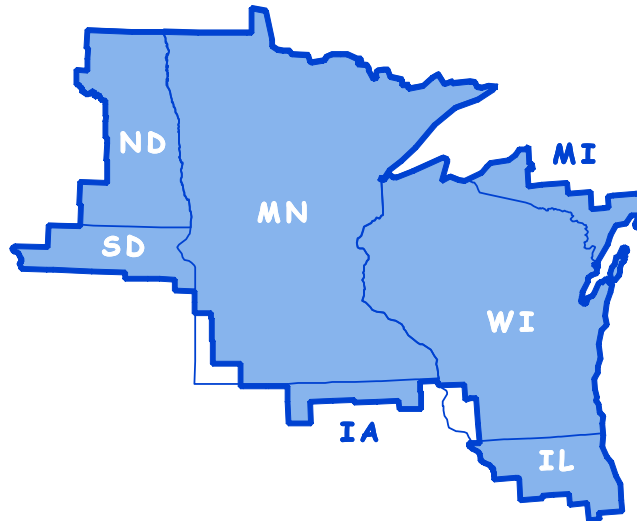

December 2009 Pool Plants

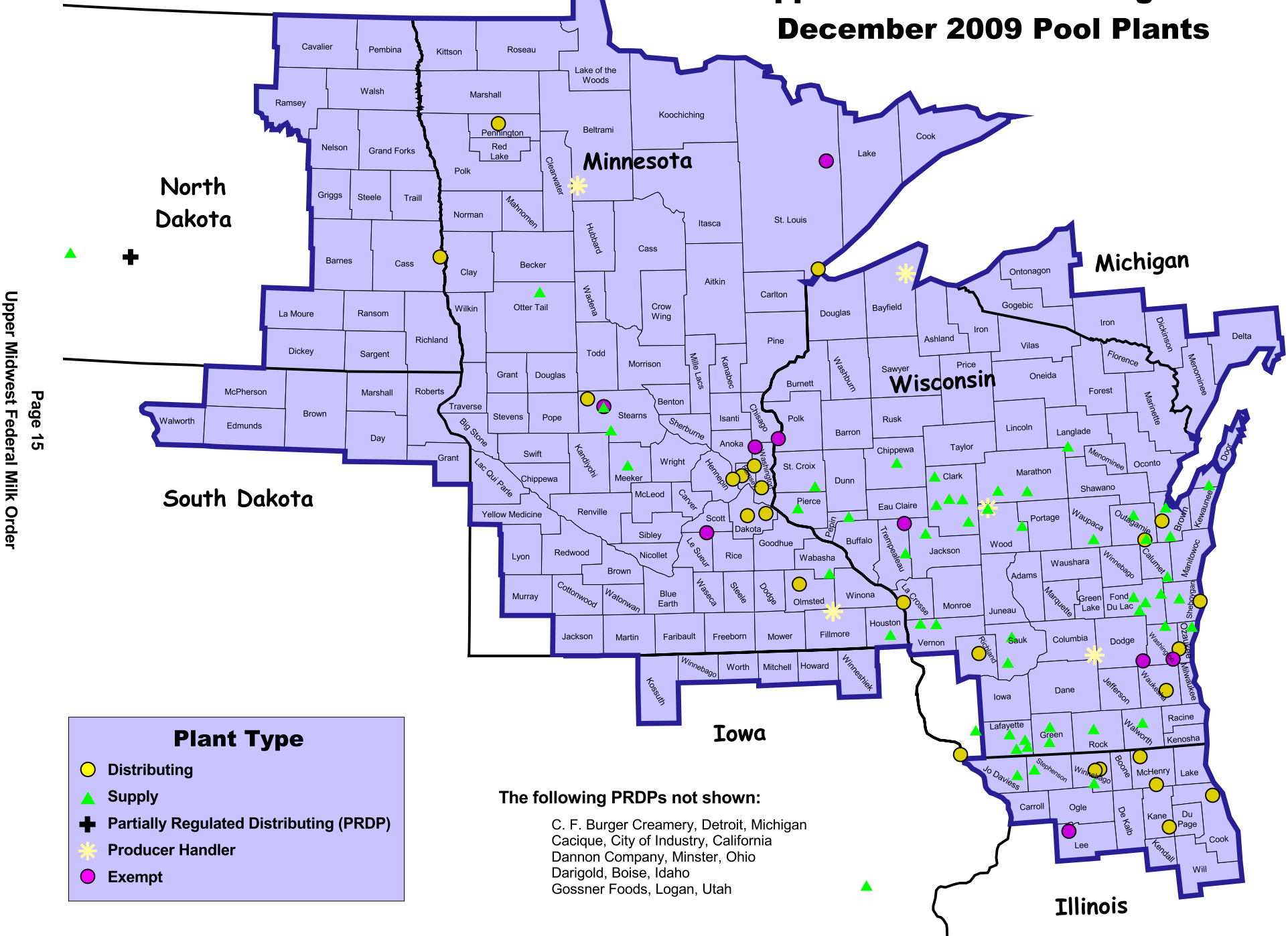

December 2008 Procurement Area

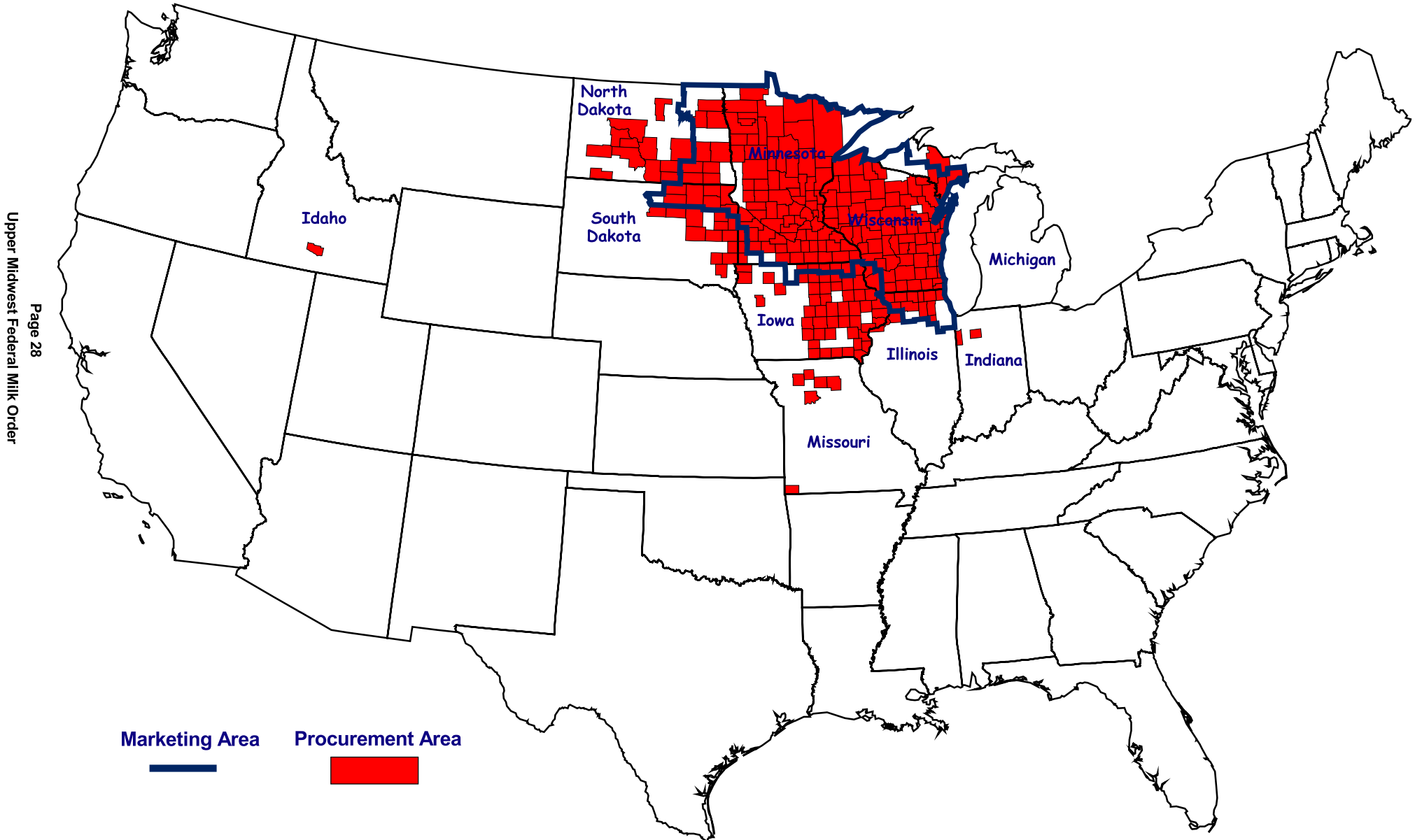

December 2009 Procurement Area

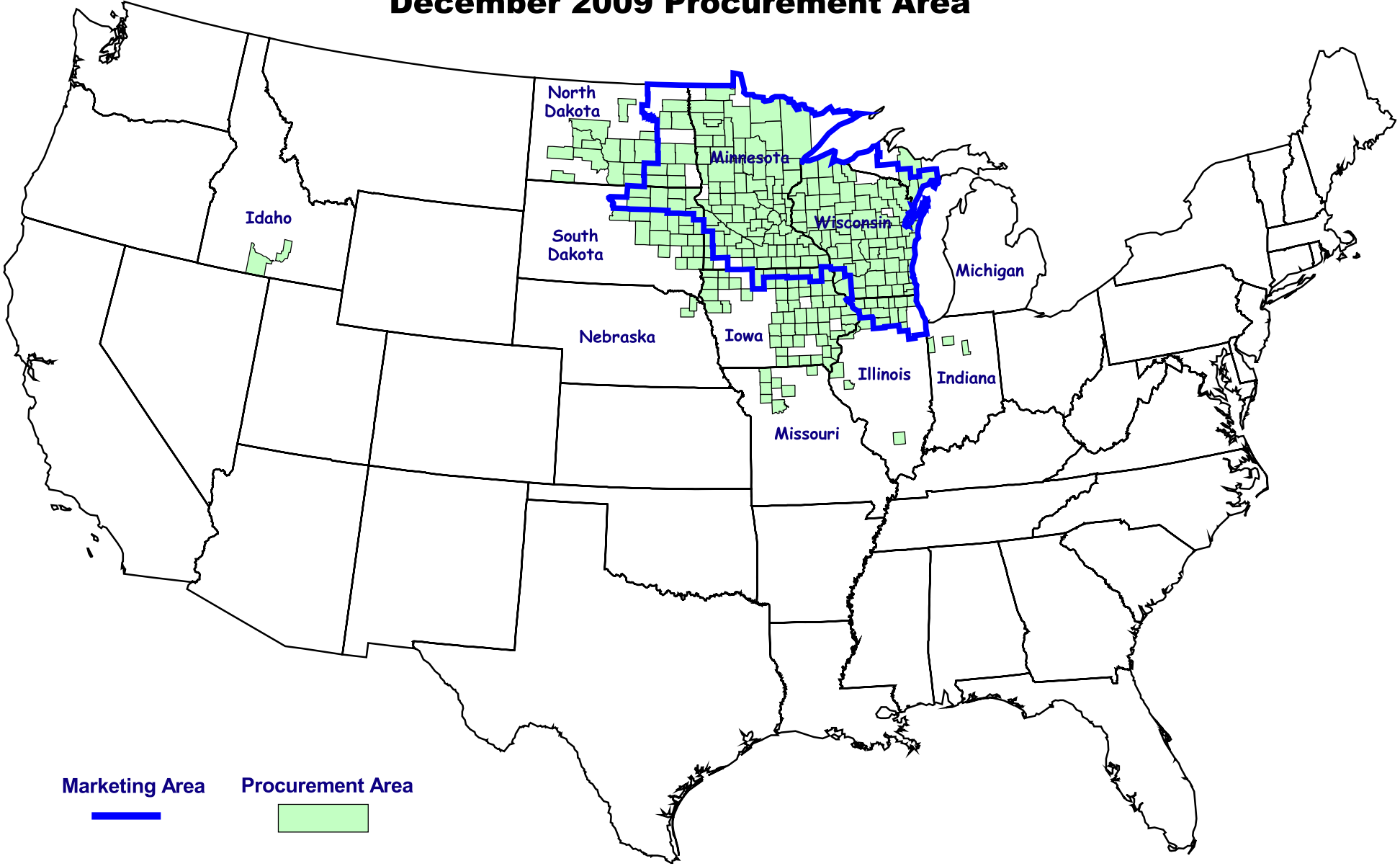
